MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear HES members and friends,

The Hellenic Evaluation Society (HES) has been very active since its creation in September 2014, pursuing the objective to provide a platform of dialogue on the evaluation, and create an active evaluation community in Greece.

In 2014-2016, the HES established its operation, started providing quality services to its members and explored opportunities for positioning itself in the international community of evaluation societies. It has also set the grounds for actions addressed to its members and to the entire community of evaluators in Greece, mainly the delivery of regular events such as training, round table discussions, etc., as well as the publication of the bi-annual journal "HES Review" as of December 2016.

Importantly, we have initiated the work toward the organisation of an annual evaluation conference in Greece as of 2017.

Work is ongoing for the development of an online learning platform, which will provide to all evaluators and commissioners of evaluations, online training and support in their evaluation works.

In the beginning of 2017 we will announce the first evaluation competition in Greece, with the idea to promote evaluation culture and encourage the Greek evaluation community to enhance capacity in carrying out quality evaluations.

Looking forward, one of our major objectives is to actively promote evaluation culture in Greece, the evaluation as a profession, and the HES as a professional association advocating for the development of professionalisation, notably via the accreditation of evaluators. We will endeavour to increase our efforts in this regard in 2017.

Our key objectives for 2017-2018 include three key directions: strengthening the quality of evaluations in Greece through capacity building and by promoting professionalisation; improving HES position as a voice for evaluation in Greece and engaging membership; and enriching public dialogue on the use of evidence and evaluation in policy making.

I want to thank and express my deep appreciation to all the volunteers, Board members, members of working groups, founding members and friends of the HES, who are providing formidable support and hard work to the achievement of this endeavour. We strongly believe that 2017 we will be able to improve and expand the HES activities in an enthusiastic way heading towards the achievement of its objectives.

2014 – 2015

The purpose of the HES Review is to provide a platform to publish and share evaluation works and articles, and a ground for cultivating a fruitful dialogue shaping the evaluation culture among policy makers and evaluators in Greece.
